Metronome speeds of 116 for Reel & Light Jig, 122 for Hop Jig, 120 for Slip Jig, 88 for Treble Jig & 138 for Hornpipe are required. \$15/dance*

NO SOLO COSTUMES ALLOWED. School Costume or leotard/skirt combo ONLY. Dancers will dance 40 bars for Reel, Light Jig, Hop Jig & Treble Jig, 32 bars for Slip Jig & Hornpipe. Metronome speeds of 113 for Reel and Slip Jig, 113 for Hornpipe, 116 for Light Jig, 118 for Hop Jig, 73 for Treble Jig required. \$15/dance

SPECIAL AWARD- BUN GRAD C dancer of the Day. The adjudicator will determine the Bun Grad C dancer of the day. To be eligible, you must participate in at least 3 Bun C competitions. The dancer of the day is a dancer who has demonstrated superior preparedness and consistent excellence in Irish Dancing. The Dancer of the Day will receive a special prize.

Pre-Open Solo Rounds:

In order to be eligible to dance in the Non-Championship Place Holder or Confined Competition, dancers must compete in at least 2 of the Pre-Open Solo Round dances. Dancers will dance 48 bars for Reel, 40 bars of Treble Jig, and 32 bars for Slip Jig & Hornpipe. Reel, SJ and HP tempo -113, Treble Jig tempo 73. \$15/dance.

NON- CHAMPIONSHIP PLACE HOLDER (NCH): This is open to dancers who have not won a Championship (judged by 1 or 3 adjudicators). One adjudicator officiates. Light and heavy dance to be performed. The winner will be Open for dances performed up to the age danced under. Having won this type of competition, competitors are debarred from further entry. Dancers must compete in at least 2 Pre-Open solo rounds or the Open Championship in order to be eligible for this competition. Dancers will compete in a 2-round championship consisting of choice of Reel (48 bars) or Slip Jig (32 bars), and Treble Jig (40 bars) or Hornpipe (32 bars). Reel, SJ tempo -113, Hard shoe Jig tempo 73, Hornpipe tempo 113. \$20 for Competition.

Open Championships: Solo rounds will be judged during the championship and awarded. Dancers will compete in a 3-round championship. Dancers will get a choice of their dances: Reel (48 bars), Slip Jig (32 bars), Treble Jig (40 bars) or Hornpipe (32 bars), and choice of set. Reel, SJ, Hornpipe tempo -113, Treble Jig 73. \$60 for Championship which includes the 2 solo round results.

Confined Competition: Dancers in any level who have not yet won a 3 adjudicator championships are eligible to compete in the confined competition. The Confined Competition will be adjudicated by 3 judges. Dancers must compete in at least 2 Pre-Open solo rounds or the Open Championship in order to be eligible for this competition. The Confined Dance will be a Reel or Slip Jig- 40 bars

An Chomhdhail Feis Rules

1. Age groups up to and including under 9 are prohibited from wearing solo costumes.
2. Dancers in Level Beginner A/B/C are prohibited from wearing solo costumes.
3. Competitions for age groups up to and including under 11 are not permitted after 6pm.
4. Children up to and including the age of 12 are prohibited from wearing face make-up.
5. All dancers are prohibited from wearing any form of glitter on their face.
6. In Beginner A, B, and C competitions, there must be a minimum of 10 competitors, and in Pre Open Competitions there must be a minimum of 5 competitors, before the winner progresses to the next grade. If there is less than these minimum numbers it is at the discretion of the Adjudicator to issue either an award or a 1st place, based on the standard rather than the number in the competition.
7. Feisanna must include a variety of traditional set dances in each session.
8. Floor measurements are set at a minimum of 16ft by 20ft for local feiseanna.
9. In the event of an injury at a feis, an incident report should be made stating how injury happened and the course of action that was taken.
10. Competitors are required to be appropriately attired at all times when attending a feis and the committee has the right to ensure that the rule is adhered to.
11. Any form of unauthorized photography which captures a dancers' image whilst taking part in competition is expressly forbidden. This covers photography by means of mobile phones, tablets, video camera, and cine recorder with or without flash facility.
12. Under the health and safety, competitors are requested not to smoke whilst dressed in their dancing costume.
13. All competitors must wear their number positioned center front, clearly displayed for adjudicators.

14. Scrutineers must be members of An Chomhdhail who will be responsible for checking the adjudicators results following each championship.

15. The decision of the adjudicator or adjudicators is final as to quality. An objection on any other grounds may be lodged by a teacher in writing on payment of a fee of 10 Euros or equivalent. The feis committee may adjudicate on such an objection if they consider themselves competent to do so, and will return the objection to the Executive of An Chomhdhail. No objection will be considered unless it is made in writing within 48 hours after the declaration of the result of the competition. Any Teacher who disagrees with the decision of a feis committee may refer the matter to the Executive of An Chomhdhail on payment of a fee of 20 Euro's or equivalent.

16. All prizes must be presented at the termination of a feis (with all competitors in full costume).

17. Adult competitions are permissible at Feiseanna provided the following criteria is adhered to :

- Ladies attire to include a simple dress or skirt and top. No cleavage to be shown and dress / skirt length to be no more than 2-inches above the knee.
- Opaque tights to be worn. Minimum 100 denier. Clothes and tights to be dark in color – Black, Navy, Wine or Forest Green.
- No wigs, poodle sock, tiara or bling to be worn.
- Gents attire to include long dark tailored trousers, shirt, tie (optional) or polo shirt.
